**Position Summary:** Under immediate supervision of the Project Manager or Foreman/Lead man, will perform any combination of duties on construction project, usually working in a utility capacity assisting other trades. Transferring from one task to another task requires workers with varied experience and knowledge. Project will include replacement of fire hydrants.

#### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Digs ditches and excavates
- Loads, unloads and moves project materials
- Cleans tools and equipment
- Cleans around project areas
- Fits pipe together with project materials
- Assists all other tradesmen as necessary
- Perform manual and other job related tasks as required
- Perform other duties as assigned

#### **Minimum Qualifications:**

- Previous experience in pipelaying or plumbing
- Previous experience working around heavy equipment in a safe and appropriate manner
- Knowledge of general construction tools and equipment
- Awareness of different piping materials
- Ability to work on uneven surfaces and
- Ability to perform work in an outdoor setting which may include inclement weather, heat, humidity and possible exposure to smoke and dust.
