Contest rules for Miss/Jr. Miss Big Pine Paiute Tribe – 2019-2020

The Miss/Jr. Miss Judges will provide a fair and honest contest and will help each contestant with any question or concerns. All contestants will receive a participation gift. Pageant will be held on Thursday, October 3, 2019 @ 6:00 pm to start off the Annual Fall Fandango. Contestants will compete in a public setting.

ELIGIBILITY:

- 1. Must be able to prove lineal decendency to Paiute or Shoshone Tribes.**
- 2. Age determination: the age of the contestant on day of the contest.**
- 3. Must reside in Big Pine Paiute Tribal Community.**

JUDGING:

All points will be accumulated – Contestants with the highest total points will win contest (ties will be broken). Judges will be asked to score each contestant as follows and their decisions will be final:

Regalia . . . 10, 20, 30, 40, or 50 points

Contestants are asked to submit the required regalia information sheet. The information will be read by the MC as each contestant “Models” her regalia. Contestants will be judged on the appropriateness and completeness of her regalia.

Cultural Talent Presentation . . . 10, 20, 30, 40, or 50 points

Each contestant will provide a cultural presentation of, song, dance, skill, language, family knowledge. Contestants will be judged on information, knowledge, and presentation.

Public Speaking (For Miss Big Pine Contestant Paiute Knowledge) . . . 10, 20, 30, 40, or 50 points

Each contestant will present for public speaking. Miss Big Pine Paiute Tribe contestants will present on a topic of Paiute Knowledge, examples; Basket making, Pine nut preparation, Alice Piper Story, Traditional Legends. They will be judged on topic and public speaking ability during presentation.

TIE BREAKER RULES:

In the event of a tie, whether as princess or 1st runner-up:

1. Tied contestants will be asked a random question. There will be no wrong or right answer to the question, this will only be an opportunity for the judges to review the contestants and select a winner.
2. Only 1 princess and 1 runner-up will be announced in each contest.

In the event of cancellation, modification of the contest, crowning of a new princess, or extending a reign will solely be at the discretion of the Committee. The Committee decision will be final.
